NATIONAL CYBER SECURITY ACADEMY

The General Director of AKCESK Mr. Igli Tafa, together with other leaders of the Authority, held a meeting with Mrs. Claire Nantier, chargé d'affaires of France, Ambassador of Slovenia Mr. Peter Japelj, and Mr. Djordje Jankovic, chargé d'affaires of Montenegro. The purpose of the meeting was to address the needs for increasing human capacities in the field of cyber security at the national level, requesting that the Regional Cyber Security Center established in Podgorica be expanded to Albania, through the establishment of the National Academy for Cyber Security.
