Within the framework of the implementation of the Action Plan of the "National Strategy for Cyber Security 2020-2025", NAECCS has continued to organize online and onsite awareness campaigns, with participants from public and private institutions, parents, teachers, children and young people, in different regions of Albania.

NAECCS is the first institution in the world that was committed to piloting the International Telecommunication Union's global project "Creating a safe and empowering digital environment for children". Also, in line with the objectives of the strategy, NAECCS is implementing the project "Transformation of the national response to human trafficking in and from Albania", implemented by UNICEF in Albania with the support of the Government of the United Kingdom.

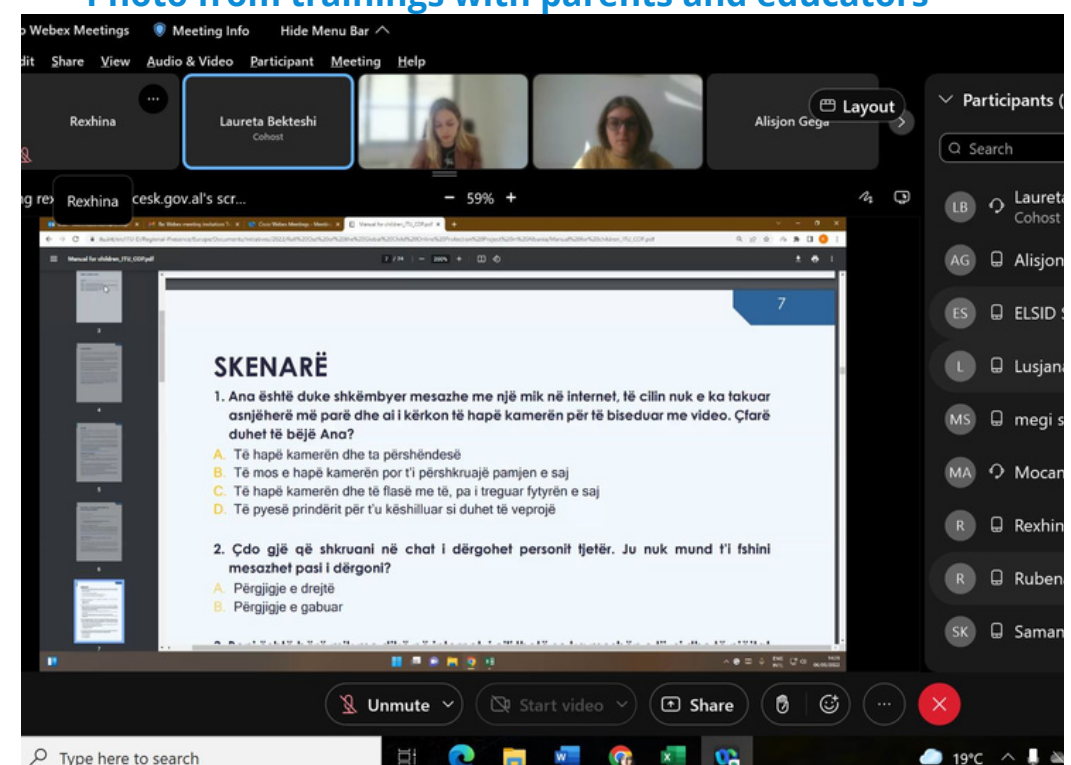

The trainings organised during May 2022 had the following target group:

- parents and teachers of High Schools and secondary schools in Babrru, Kamëz, Paskuqan, Vorë, Kavaje, Kukës, Shkodër, Has, Vau Dejës, Fushë Arrëz, Pukë, Tropoja, Dibër, Klos, Burrel, Bulqizë
- Child Protection Units in the district of Tirana, Dibra, Shkodra and Kukës
- Internet Service Providers, who operate in the Republic of Albania

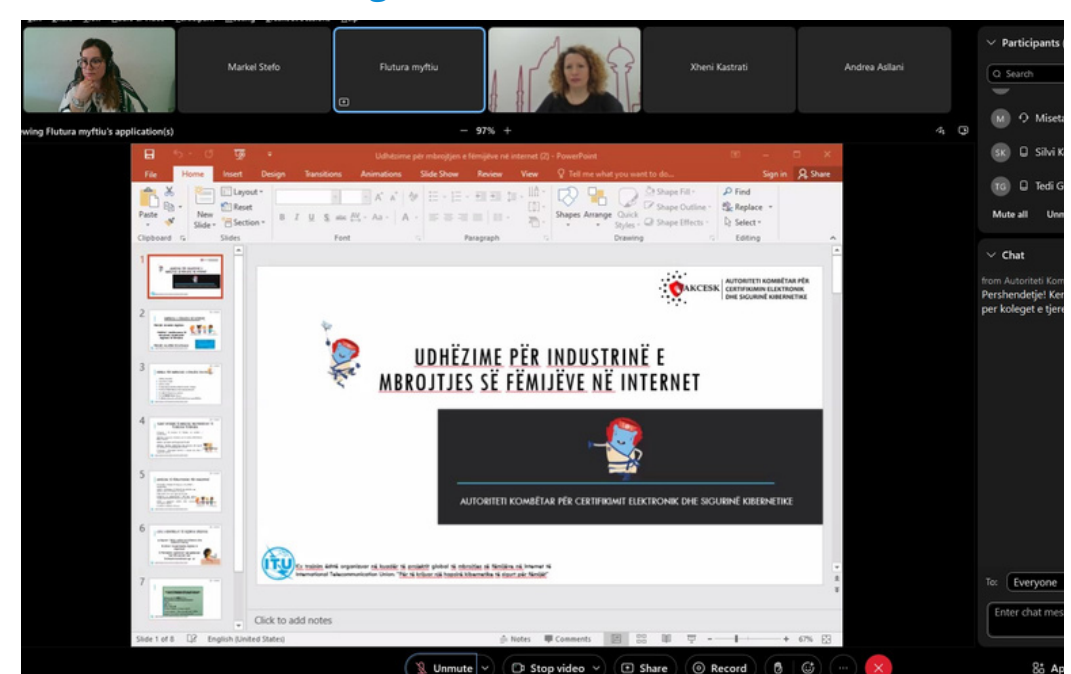
