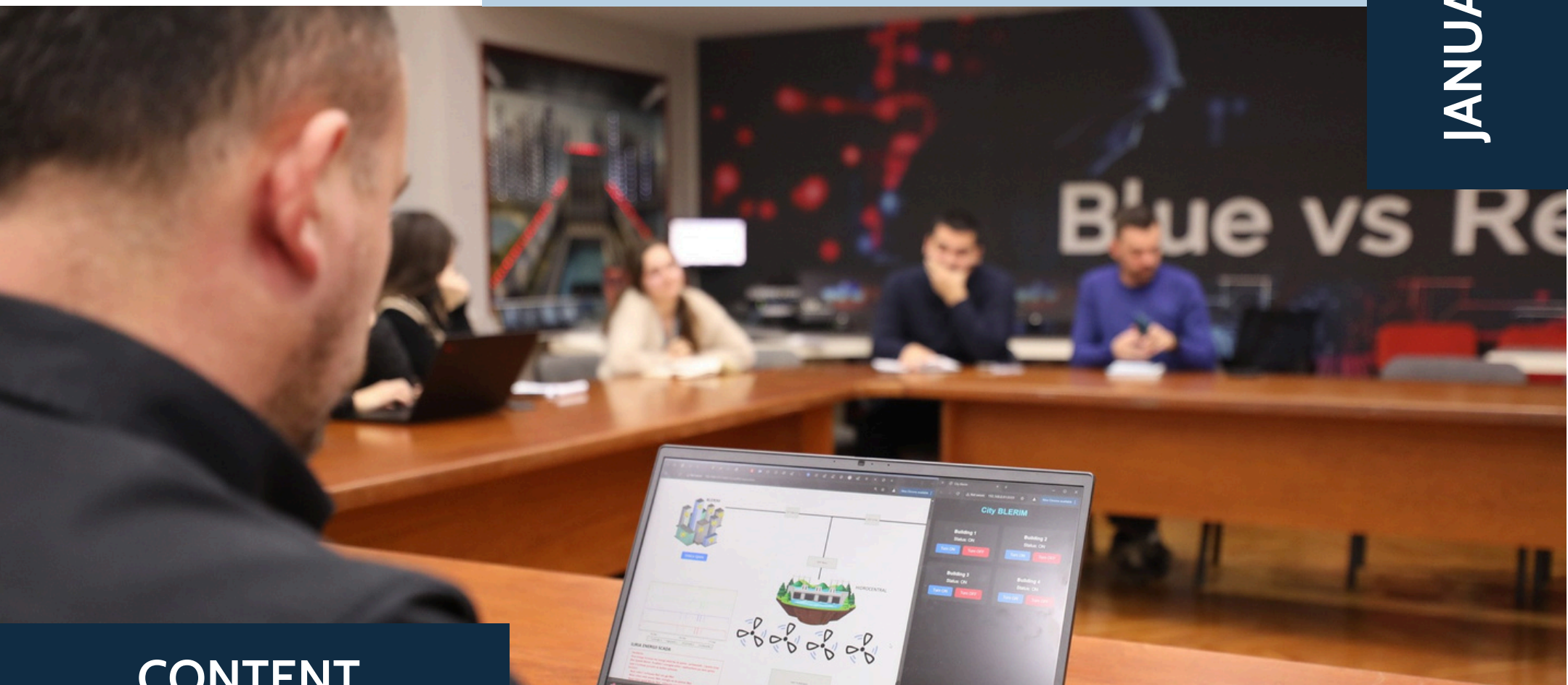

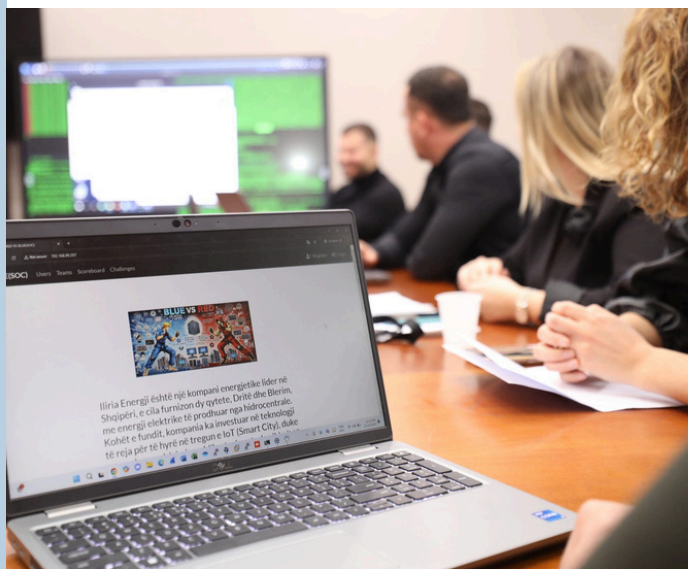

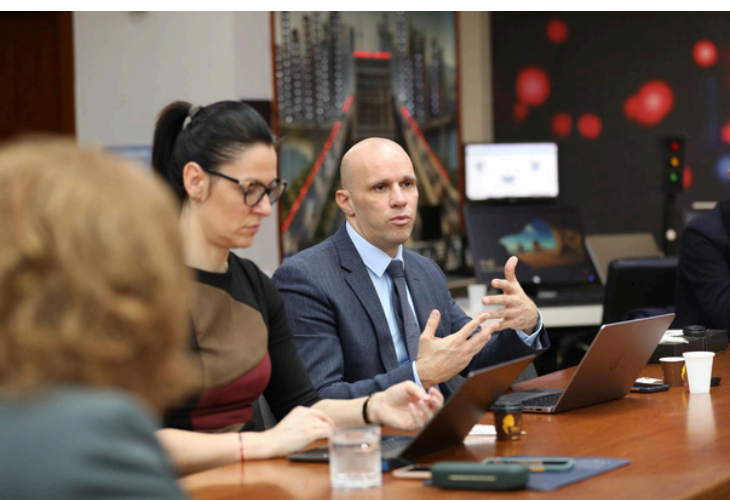

Red vs Blue Team Simulation is organized in the Cybersecurity Laboratory of NCSA



In a simulation environment, the Red Team tested the vulnerabilities of critical systems, aiming for maximum impact on the SCADA/PLC systems of cities through simulated attacks. On the other hand, the Blue Team engaged in monitoring, detecting, and stopping these actions in real-time.

The results of this simulation contribute to identifying areas for improvement, strengthening the security of critical systems, and reducing the impact of potential cyberattacks.



Discussions on Strengthening Cybersecurity: Bilateral Meeting with the Regional Cooperation Council

NCSA held a bilateral meeting with the Regional Cooperation Council (RCC) regarding the country's needs in the field of cybersecurity. Representatives from NCSA, AKSHI, the Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy (MIE), the Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs (MEPJ), and the State Police presented the current cybersecurity situation in the country and addressed the needs in this area.

The discussions also focused on the creation of a regional data hub for cybersecurity projects in the Western Balkans. This meeting was part of a joint initiative by the European Commission (EC), the Regional Cooperation Council (RCC), and the Integrative Internal Security Governance (IISG), aiming to coordinate and strengthen cybersecurity capacities in the region.

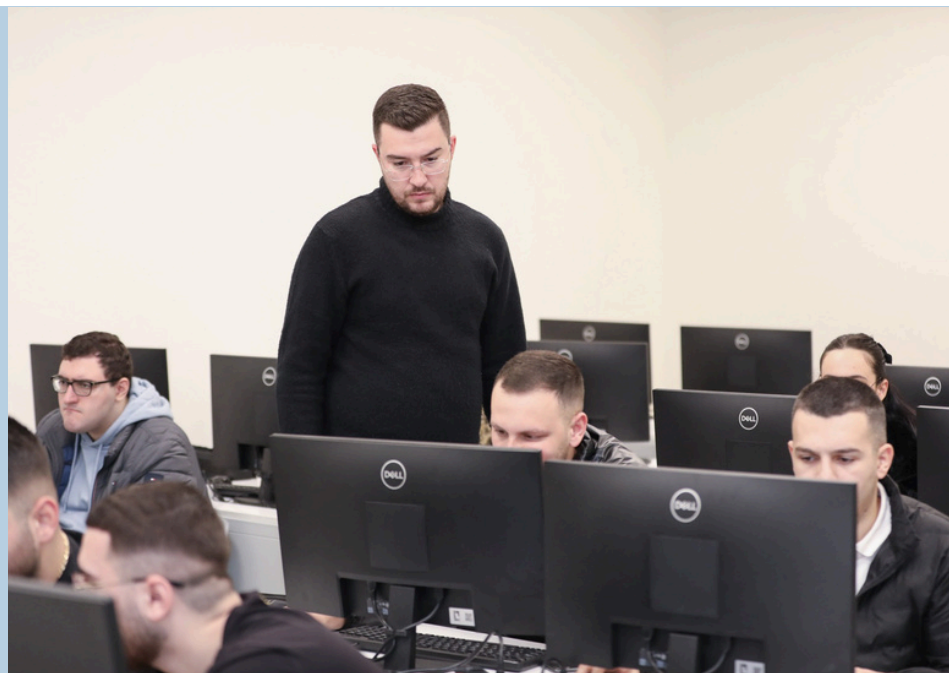
Cyber Drill for Students of the University of New York
